Stage crew to meet at 5pm on Wednesday 9th September to plan for the Second Semester Music Concert, which will be the modified format of 5.45-7pm for Junior and 7-8pm for Senior concerts. Neither concert will include a slideshow due to the smaller venue size and potential interference with the videotaping.

The Sundowner is still planned for Friday 4th December with performances from the Music Program. Concurrently, SVAPA will have an art show in the Tricycle, and be responsible for the art and venue security. Catering costs will be shared. Amanda will produce promotional fliers.

There will also be performances at the Final Assembly and the Graduation Ceremony at the Perth Convention Centre.
