4. President's Report

Suzie provided a written report, with the call-outs being:

- <u>Fundraising</u>: pleasing efforts last year and noted the need for better planning around the 'fundraising letter';
- <u>Uniform Shop</u>: is now up a running with minimal debt and acknowledgement of the volunteers for their efforts / parents & students for their patience as we have worked through 1st year teething issues;
- <u>SVAPA & Music Committees</u>: been very busy with kids benefiting from fundraising efforts with subsidised trips (Broome and - this year - China);
- Principal change: sad farewell to Terry welcome to Milton.

6. Principal's Report

Milton commenced the report by providing the P&C with some personal insights:

- Has a recent history in schools that have the Middle School concept, and also schools used as a "control school" for the OBE
- Objective is to leave the school in a better state than it is when he started, acknowledging it is already a great school. To this end the priorities are:

- o rigour around teaching and working to "stretch" students to achieve
- o getting teachers to engage with students, parents etc for earlier intervention where required, eg lower than expected achievement
- o within 10 years the school to be a "Top 20" for TEE achievement
- Acknowledged and thanked the parent community for its support, and strong turn-out this evening

Some notes taken from a slide show on the school:

- Year 9 Student assessment (against state): MLSHS performed very well with most of the results above the state benchmarks
- Year 12 cohort:
 - 41% of TEE achieved Uni entrance level; 1 Certificate of Distinction and 8 Certificates of Excellence;
 - Graduation rate and Non TEE student results lower than expected ... focus for this year
 - o Push to include WAAPA results in reporting
 - MLSHS is best in Swan District and compares favourably with Churchlands and Shenton College
- <u>Staff</u>: fully staffed to commence the year. Expectation that there will be impacts for industrial action in near term
- Schedule of fees: English and Special Program fees were not applied or need to be amended, school will address this soon
- <u>Tutoring Australia</u>: last year or 2 school coordinated this. Is there an interest this year, if the P&C run with it the cost is significantly reduced for the student.
- Get statistics on usage over last year. P&C may take this up.
 - <u>China Trip</u>: added some staff, now 3 chinese speaking adults and 9 teaching staff attending.

Question from floor: is there data available on the incidents of behavioural issues or suspensions ... no, but can get if required.

7. Uniform Shop Report

Cheryl presented a written report:

- 2007 turn-over \$330,000, with new items introduced
 - o backpack, 100 sold
 - o scarf, proving popular
 - o phys ed shirt and shorts, very popular
- 2008 already traded \$220,000 and looking forward to new school blazer. Shipment of jumpers due in March and April
- Some delay in uniform items due to 3 weeks "manufacturing holiday"
- Huge thanks to Suzie, and the many (18) volunteers.
