5.3. Principal's Report

Milton commenced the report with:

- bringing attention to the Booklet and Bookmark that provide information and inspiration
- School Plan in draft and will be available shortly. Also raised a document on the "school's aims"
- Discuss the "school's aims" at the next meeting. Seeking P&C endorsement.

Some notes taken from a slide show on the school:

- Survey sent last year results are quite polarised "good feedback, but more of it" (parents), "more rigour in programs" (teachers) etc
- Encouraging teachers to reflect on how to set expectation of students ... intent being achieving students, high quality staff, involvement in the community, etc resulting in a "school of choice" with results regularly in Top20
- Implement a writing strategy ... students need English and some Year 12's are not getting required results
- NAPLAN '08 recorded strong results across the learning areas, numeracy excepted
- MSE9 recorded better than State average
- Year 12 cohort:
 - 3 Certificate of Excellence; 16 with TER 90 or better; 46% 80 or better ... not as many at high end, but more getting 80 or better
 - o Graduation rate lower than State average ... some academic targets to be set this year
 - Very strong Year 8 contingent ... based on last year's NAPLAN results
- Other:
 - o trying to keep the Volleyball program running
 - o trying to schedule more time for language studies
 - o testing for SVAPA 2010 to start soon
 - o acknowledgment of support from Uniform Shop
 - o \$195k grant for "Healthy Active program" ... appointment made, to facilitate the efforts congratulations Suzie
 - o want to honour the huge contribution made over many years by Christine Richardson

Question from floor: can we tap the Government \$14bn to get Aircon or Music Department works ... NO, it has fairly stringent criteria

- 2008 turn-over \$227,774 on over 2,000 transactions
- some supply problems ... assurances received that it will get better ... early indication is positive
