This gives us venue security and although paid, the organisation and strategic process of planning tickets and student performances is important. We collected \$3,600 from ticket sales. Some discussion was raise regarding ticket purchase prices.
- Money for technician hire on the night has been finalised and paid in cash.
- Term One for Denise's contract next year must be prioritised. Denise's role is paramount in the Music department and her funding is very low. While the Music Support Committee is going to help fund Denise's pay we say it is necessary to discuss the broader context. Two highlighted points are as follows: (A) Denise work would be very important to develop correspondence and organisation for the new 2017, music students. The quicker this is in place the quicker the students' lessons and practice begins.

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(B) Music support committee request of our committee to develop a framework that advises of where incoming monies received are then allocated and spent by the Music support committee. This would be a public document.
