 - Made \$349 from food and drink sales = \$839 profit
- Max capacity 80 so alternate groups of 40 can play a variety of game formats
- Games are 10min, can fit 12 games into 3 hrs so each group would get 6 games
- Can bring own food and drinks

Pro

- Is in shopping center Karryinup, enough parking and shopping possibilities for parents in the meantime.
